

## GENERAL COURSE STRUCTURE OF B.A. PROGRAMME

- (a) Compulsory Courses : These papers/courses are compulsory for all students of the programme concerned.
- (b) Major Courses : Major courses shall be started from Vth Semester onwards.
- (c) Elective Courses : Elective subject combinations/ courses shall be taught as per the subjects/ papers offered from Ist to IVth Semester.
- (d) Skill Based Courses : A Skill Based Course shall be mandatory for all Students pursuing B.A. IVth Semester. The College shall offer Skill Based Course as approved by the University.

## CURRICULUM

### BA 1<sup>ST</sup> SEMESTER

- (a) Compulsory Subject : English Compulsory
- (b) Elective Subject : Any one combination from the following:
1. Elective English, History, Political Science
  2. Elective English, History, Economics
  3. Political Science, Geography, Economics
  4. Elective English, Economics, Geography
  5. Economics, Political Science, History
  6. Hindi, History, Geography
  7. Hindi, Geography, Political Science

**NOTE: OTHER THAN THE SEVEN (07) ABOVE MENTIONED COMBINATIONS OF SUBJECTS, NO OTHER SUBJECT COMBINATIONS OR MIXTURE OF SUBJECTS ARE ALLOWED. THE COMBINATION OF SUBJECT SHOULD BE CHOSEN RIGHTLY AS GIVEN IN THE PROSPECTUS. COMBINATION ONCE CHOSEN CANNOT BE CHANGED LATER**

## **B.A. II<sup>nd</sup> SEMESTER:**

- Compulsory Paper : English Compulsory Paper-II
- Elective Papers : Continuation of three subjects offered during the First Semester Subjects

## **B.A. III<sup>rd</sup> SEMESTER:**

- Compulsory Paper : Environmental Studies (EVS)
- Elective Papers : Continuation of three subjects offered during the First & Second Semester Subjects

## **B.A. IV<sup>th</sup> SEMESTER:**

- Compulsory Course : Skill Based Courses(The skill based courses Approved by the Rajiv Gandhi University shall be prescribed separately according to the recommendations of concerned Board of Studies constituted by the University). The students opting skill based courses on any subject of his/ her choice shall continue as Major Subject from V<sup>th</sup> Semester onwards.
- Elective Papers : Continuation of three subjects offered during the First, Second & Third Semester.

## **B.A. V<sup>th</sup> SEMESTER:**

- Major Subjects : Any one subject chosen as Skilled Based Course during the IV<sup>th</sup> Semester shall be taught as Paper V, VI, VII & VIII.

## **B.A. VI<sup>th</sup> SEMESTER:**

Paper IX, X, XI & XII to be taught in continuation of the V<sup>th</sup> semester
